

IMPORTANT CHANGES AND REMINDERS FOR TAX YEAR 2018

The due date for filing a return is April 15, 2019

Cash payments for income tax are no longer be accepted. Payments may be made via check, money order or debit/credit card in our offices, via our website – www.kentoncity.com or by calling 1-866-917-7368 (processing fees will be charged).

If you are 65 years of age or older with no city taxable income, please mark the appropriate box on the tax return in Section A and provide proof of your age/type of income. Once you have provided this information, you will not be required to file a Kenton tax return in future years unless your type of income changes.

Effective 1/1/2016, the minimum late filing penalty is \$25.00 per month up to a maximum of \$150.00.

Effective 1/1/2016, the minimum refund or credit carryforward is \$10.00.

Effective 1/1/2016, the non-payment penalty is 15% of the tax unpaid by the return due date.

This packet contains information for Individual Filers only. Business Filers may obtain a return by printing a form from our website (www.kentoncity.com) or by contacting the Tax Department. Effective for tax year 2018, the operating loss-carryforward follows the Ohio Revised Code special rules in tax years 2018 through 2022. Please review ORC 718 for more information.

Kenton extension to file requests must be filed by April 15, 2019. Your timely filed Kenton or Federal extension must be attached to your return to avoid late filing penalties. An extension to file is not an extension to pay, therefore estimated taxes should be paid with the extension request to avoid non-payment penalty. CREDIT FOR TAXES PAID TO OTHER CITIES WILL BE ALLOWED.

Just a reminder that the City of Kenton has mandatory filing. ***Even if you had no income, you must file a tax return.*** Please contact our office at 419-673-1355 for more information on filing your tax return.

No electronic filing of tax returns is available. ***If you have a tax preparer complete your Kenton Income Tax Return, you are responsible for submitting the return to the City of Kenton Income Tax Department.***

Before submitting your return, please verify that all the required information has been attached including W-2s showing Medicare wages and city tax(es) withheld, 1099s, Schedule C(s), Schedule E(s), etc. An incomplete return is not a filed return and can subject your account to late filing penalties.
